Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant increase in the amount of \$221,725 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Population Affairs through Essential Access Health for a total amount of \$301,725 for participation in a program, entitled "Title X Family Planning Program," for the period of April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023.

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Population Affairs (DHHS), through Essential Access Health (EAH) as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$301,725 for participation in a program, entitled "Title X Family Planning Program," for the period of April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, The funding will strengthen the overall quality of the Family Planning Program and its ability to meet the needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, DPH will provide comprehensive family planning health services to Title X clients of reproductive age to plan and space their pregnancies; and

WHEREAS, DPH will also provide family planning education, medical services and effective medically approved family planning methods and services, either on site or by referral for female clients; and

WHEREAS, DPH will also provide a broad range of acceptable and effective medically approved family planning methods (including natural family planning methods) and services (including infertility services and services for adolescents); and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$221,725 to an original award amount of \$80,000 was approved by EAH for the period of April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the original award agreement on April 7, 2022, for a project start date of April 1, 2022, and the amendment on September 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The grant terms requires a minimum cost sharing of \$30,172.50; and WHEREAS, The cost sharing will be funded from the San Francisco City and County General Fund; and

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$301,725 from the DHHS through EAH; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.
