[Grant Agreement Amendment - Compass Family Services - Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool - Not to Exceed \$29,151,597]

Resolution approving the second amendment to the grant agreement between the Compass Family Services and the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing ("HSH") for supportive services and administration of a Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool program for families; extending the grant term by 24 months from June 30, 2024, for a total term of October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2026; increasing the agreement amount by \$20,183,620 for a total amount not to exceed \$29,151,597; and authorizing HSH to enter into any amendments or other modifications to the agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities, or materially decrease the benefits to the City and are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the agreement.

WHEREAS, The mission of the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing ("HSH" or "Department") is to prevent homelessness when possible and make homelessness rare, brief, and one-time in the City and County of San Francisco ("the City") through the provision of coordinated, compassionate, and high-quality services; and

WHEREAS, Permanent supportive housing ("PSH") is the most effective evidencebased solution to chronic homelessness; and

WHEREAS, In 2020 the City launched the Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool ("FHSP") program to provide scattered site PSH in private market apartments for people exiting homelessness; and

WHEREAS, As of the 2022 Point-in-Time Count, there were approximately 7,750 people experiencing homelessness in San Francisco on any given night, 56% of whom were unsheltered; and

WHEREAS, The nonprofit provider Compass Family Services ("Compass") has extensive experience operating supportive housing for families; and

WHEREAS, HSH entered into a grant agreement ("Agreement") in 2022 for the term October 1, 2022, through March 31, 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$8,967,977 with Compass to provide services, including supportive services and subsidy administration, for 165 families through the FHSP, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors ("Clerk") in File No. 240337; and

WHEREAS, In Fiscal Year 2022-2023, Compass served 85 households through this Agreement with 23 new placements that year; and

WHEREAS, The program continues to gradually ramp up by adding a sustainable amount of new referrals each month until it reaches the maximum capacity of 165 households; and

WHEREAS, HSH executed a no-cost first amendment to the Agreement in April 2024 that extended the Agreement term for Compass to continue providing these services by three months to June 30, 2024, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk in File No. 240337; and

WHEREAS, The proposed second amendment ("Amendment") to the Agreement would extend the Agreement for Compass to continue to provide these services by 24 months to June 30, 2024, and increase the not to exceed amount by \$20,183,620 for a total amount not to exceed \$29,151,597; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved using Proposition C (2018) (Gross Receipts Tax for Homelessness Services) ("Prop C"), passed by San Francisco voters in November 2018, to fund the Our City, Our Home ("OCOH") Fund, in order to expand and complement existing funding and strategic efforts to prevent and end homelessness for San Franciscans, including housing programming; and

WHEREAS, 100% of this agreement is funded with Prop C dollars; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the Amendment is on file with the Clerk in File No. 240337, substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Amendment requires Board of Supervisors approval under Section 9.118 of the Charter; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Executive Director of HSH ("Director") or their designee to execute the Amendment to extend the current term of October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024, to October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2026, and to increase the not to exceed amount by \$20,183,620 for a total amount not to exceed \$29,151,597; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director or their designee to enter into any amendments or modifications to the Amendment, prior to its final execution by all parties, that HSH determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City or materially decrease the benefits to the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the grant, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Amendment being executed by all parties, HSH shall submit to the Clerk a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 240337; this requirement and obligation resides with HSH, and is for the purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved agreement.
