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6 WHEREAS, The Department of Aging and Adult Services is required to conduct a
7 participatory Dignity Fund Community Needs Assessment (DFCNA); and,

8 WHEREAS, The Needs Assessment process requires robust data collection in order to
9 identify the strengths, opportunities, challenges, and gaps present in the current services
10 landscape, to support an equitable and data-informed Service and Allocation Plan; and

11 WHEREAS, The Needs Assessment identified gaps in service visibility and outreach,
12 support for in-home caregivers, and limitations in client data; and

13 WHEREAS, The Needs Assessment makes specific recommendations about
14 expanded marketing campaigns, an updated Equity Analysis, and to support caregivers; and

15 WHEREAS, The Department of Aging and Adult Services plans to present their
16 DFCNA to the Budget and Finance Committee together with their Budget Presentation on
17 June 15, 2018, to be available on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
18 No. 180574 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, The City Charter requires that the Board of Supervisors shall consider and
21 approve or disapprove, or modify, the Community Needs Assessment; and

22 WHEREAS, Following approval of the Needs Assessment, the Department of Aging
23 and Adult Services will undertake the creation of a Service and Allocation plan in FY2018-
24 2019; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the 2017-2018 Dignity
2 Fund Community Needs Assessment.




