WHEREAS, These workers are responsible for performing their duties responsibly and with punctuality to ensure seamless and safe operations at SFO; and

WHEREAS, These workers have been on strike since the beginning of April in an effort to maintain adequate economic security and affordable health care for themselves and their families; and

WHEREAS, Flying Food Group, has not offered economic compensation to adequately meet the expectations of these workers, nor have they been negotiating in good faith, which in turn has prolonged this labor dispute; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco and SFO have a history of labor harmony and peace provisions in contracts, support for airport workers, support for workers exercising their autonomy over their own labor, and strong public policies to support worker protections; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby recognizes the essential and difficult work performed by members of Teamsters Local 2785 at Flying Foods; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the parties to immediately resume good faith bargaining so that these workers can return to work with dignity and economic security.
