Administrative Code, Chapter 21.1, through an Invitation for Bids issued by the Office of
Contract Administration on March 9, 2022, under Sourcing Event 0000006284 for the
purchase of multiple chemicals, Ferric Ferrous Chloride (Aggregate 1); Sodium
Hypochlorite (Aggregate 2), Sodium Hydroxide (Aggregate 3), Hydrofluosilicic Acid
(Aggregate 4), Sodium Bisulfite (Aggregate 5), Aluminum Sulfate (Aggregate 6), Calcium
Thiosulfate (Aggregate 7), Sulfuric Acid (Aggregate 8), Citric Acid (Aggregate 9),
Antiscalant (Aggregate 10), GreenClean Liquid 5.0 Algaecide (Aggregate 11), Lime
(Aggregate 12) and Sodium Hypochlorite Small Sites (Aggregate 13); and

WHEREAS, Sourcing Event 0000006284 resulted in a primary award for the lowest responsive bidder for each Aggregate and, where applicable, a secondary award for the second lowest responsive bidder for each Aggregate; and

WHEREAS, Sourcing Event 0000006284 resulted in the primary award of Aggregate 2 to Univar Solutions USA Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder (PeopleSoft Contract ID 1000025302); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors, under Charter, Section 9.118(b), hereby authorizes the Purchaser and Director of the Office of Contract Administration to execute PeopleSoft Contract ID 1000025302 between the City and County of San Francisco and Univar Solutions USA Inc. for the purchase of Sodium Hypochlorite, an initial contract not to exceed amount of \$32,000,000 for three years and \$42,000,000 for an option to extend for four additional years for a total not to exceed amount of \$74,000,000 and a total contract duration of seven years to commence on July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2029; and, be it
