RESOLUTION NO. 402-24

[Agreement Amendment - HDR Engineering Inc. - Construction Management Staff Augmentation Services for the New Headworks Facility Project - Not to Exceed \$31,680,626]

Resolution authorizing the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute Amendment No. 3 to the New Headworks Facility Construction Management Staff Augmentation Services Agreement PRO.0028 with HDR Engineering Inc.; increasing the agreement by \$4,680,626 for a total not to exceed amount of \$31,680,626 and extending the duration by one year, for a total term of eight years and six months of June 15, 2017, through December 14, 2025, to reflect the re-scoping efforts and increased level of staffing needed to complete the construction of the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant New Headworks Facility, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118.

WHEREAS, The Southeast Water Pollution Treatment Plant (SEP) is San Francisco's oldest and largest waste water facility, treating 80% of the San Francisco's wastewater; and

WHEREAS, The City built the SEP in 1952, and many of its facilities are operating beyond their useful life and, through the Sewer System Improvement Program, the SEP is undergoing operational improvements and upgrades in order to ensure the reliability of the sewer system and to protect the health of our community and environment; and

WHEREAS, The Headworks facility currently houses one of the most odorous treatment processes in the City's wastewater treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, The existing fine screening and grit removal processes are inefficient, which significantly impact the performance of downstream processes at the SEP that result in noxious odors released in the community; and

WHEREAS, The New Headworks Facility Project (Project) is constructing a new

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headworks facility, modifying the Bruce Flynn Pump Station, and constructing a new odor control structure; and

WHEREAS, On March 28, 2017, by Resolution No. 17-0059, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) awarded agreement No. PRO.0028, New Headworks Facility Construction Management Staff Augmentation Services (Agreement), and authorized the General Manager of the SFPUC to negotiate and execute a professional services agreement with a not to exceed amount of \$17,000,000, and with a duration of six years, with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR), subject to Board of Supervisors' approval pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, On May 16, 2017, by Resolution No. 191-17, this Board of Supervisors authorized the General Manager of the SFPUC to execute the Agreement with HDR, for an amount not to exceed \$17,000,000 with a term of up to six years, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, On July 14, 2020, by Resolution No. 20-0152, the SFPUC authorized the General Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with HDR, increasing the agreement by \$10,000,000 for a total agreement amount of \$27,000,000, and extending the term by one year for a total duration of seven years, subject to Board of Supervisors' approval pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, On March 9, 2021, by Resolution No. 102-21, this Board of Supervisors authorized the General Manager of the SFPUC to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with HDR, increasing the agreement by \$10,000,000 for a total amount of \$27,000,000, and extending the term by one year for a total duration of seven years, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, On May 07, 2024, by Resolution No.09-0017, the General Manager of the SFPUC executed Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with HDR, increasing the contract

Public Utilities Commission BOARD OF SUPERVISORS duration by six months, for a total contract duration of up to seven years and six months with no change to the agreement amount; and

WHEREAS, Construction Contract No. WW-628, Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant New Headworks Facility, is a Construction Manager/ General Contractor (CM/GC) contract and uses a project delivery method that allows the contractor to review design documents and provide design cost estimates, as well as constructability reviews, at various milestones; and

WHEREAS, This project delivery method also allows the design of certain scopes of work to be performed concurrently with construction; and

WHEREAS, The project re-scope under the proposed Amendment No. 3 will include rehabilitating the existing lift station by installing new pumps, screening, electrical, and odor control equipment; relocating the new odor control structure after the construction of the new facility; coordination and construction management support due to scope changes, and construction support for power delivery of a full system start-up and its operation; and

WHEREAS, On May 28, 2024, by Resolution No. 24-0123, the SFPUC authorized the General Manager to execute Amendment No. 3 the Agreement with HDR, increasing the agreement by \$4,680,626 for a total not to exceed amount of \$31,680,626 and with a time extension of one year, for a total duration of eight years and six months, to reflect the rescoping efforts and increased level of staffing needed to complete the construction of the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant New Headworks Facility, subject to the Board of Supervisors approval pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Charter, Section 9.119, the SFPUC seeks Board of Supervisors authorization for Amendment No. 3, increasing the agreement amount by \$4,680,626 for a total not to exceed amount of \$31,680,626, and with a time extension of one year, for a total duration of eight years and six months, to reflect the re-scoping efforts and

Public Utilities Commission BOARD OF SUPERVISORS increased level of staffing needed to complete the construction of the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant New Headworks Facility; and

WHEREAS, Contract Monitoring Division established a 20% Local Business Enterprise (LBE) sub-consulting requirement for this agreement and HDR has committed to 24.96% LBE participation; and

WHEREAS, Funds for this amendment are available from Project CWWSIPSE02 – SEP New Headworks (Grit) Replacement; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors herby authorizes the General Manager of the SFPUC to execute Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. PRO.0028 New Headworks Facility Construction Management Staff Augmentation Services with HDR, to increase the agreement by \$4,680,626 for a total not to exceed amount of \$31,680,626 and with a time extension of one year, for a total duration of eight years and six months, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

FURTHER BE RESOLVED, That within 30 days of Amendment No. 3 being fully executed by all parties, the SFPUC shall provide the resigned revised contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
