[Supporting Workers' Rights to Free Speech and Contract Implementation]

WHEREAS, On June 29, 2023, three United Auto Workers, Local 2865 union members at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD) were arrested, charged with felonies, and held in jail overnight for allegedly chalking a building with pro-worker slogans to protest the University of California's refusal to implement negotiated union contracts; and

WHEREAS, After staging a demonstration on May 5, 2023, about the administration's failure to abide by contract requirements, 67 UCSD graduate students are now facing disciplinary hearings and possible expulsion; and

WHEREAS, In Southern California, at a hotel run by the University of California pension fund, picketing workers from UNITE HERE, Local 11 who are seeking contracts for living wages and health benefit increases were assaulted on the picket line at the instigation of management; and

WHEREAS, The right to engage in free speech and peaceful protest is enshrined in the United States Constitution and both the National Labor Relations Act and California's Meyers-Milias-Brown Act that protect workers' rights to engage in protected union activity free from employer threats or retaliation and require public employers to work in good faith with their employees; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco demand that the University of California respect workers' rights to engage in protected union

activity, immediately implement the terms of signed union contracts, and cease retaliatory actions and drop all charges relating to workers' engaging in free speech and peaceful protests; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco directs the Clerk of the Board to send a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Regents of the University of California and all its members, including Appointed, Ex Officio, Student, and Designate Regents and Faculty Representatives and Advisors to the Regents.
