WHEREAS, The Department of Children Youth and Their Families (DCYF) applied for funding on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco for the David and Katherine deWilde Grant; and

WHEREAS, David and Katherine deWilde will distribute a grant of \$500,000 to the City and County of San Francisco for the support to community and school-based organizations to provide math and literacy programming for Summer Together Program June 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DCYF is hereby authorized to expend the interest income earned on this grant from David and Katherine deWilde; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor, or alternatively the Executive Director of DCYF, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco in connection with the David and Katherine deWilde award, and to enter into, execute, and deliver any and all documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to be awarded the David and Katherine deWilde award, and all amendments thereto, including the grant proposal for this funding and the Grant Agreement with David and Katherine deWilde; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by David and Katherine deWilde; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully executed by all parties, DCYF shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
