[Accept and Expend Grant - California Department of Water Resources - San Francisco Zoo Recycled Water Project - Not to Exceed \$538,051]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to accept and expend grant funds of up to \$538,051 from the California Department of Water Resources for the pipeline construction of the San Francisco Zoo Recycled Water Project, pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1(b), for the period of October 1, 2023, through December 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) staff have developed a project to construct a new recycled water pipeline to convert the San Francisco Zoo's (Zoo) current groundwater supply and distribution system to a recycled water supply and distribution system, except for end uses that require potable water, otherwise known as Water Enterprise Capital Improvement Project No. 10037519, San Francisco Zoo Recycled Water Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, The Project will be a local water project that will provide regional water supply and reliability benefits to SFPUC's Regional Water System and the Westside Groundwater Basin by maximizing the SFPUC's potable water supply, thereby reducing pressure on existing supplies likely to be stressed by climate change; and

WHEREAS, Under the State Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 (Proposition 1), the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) issued a the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to fund local projects within the San Francisco Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, On December 11, 2018, SFPUC applied for a Proposition 1 grant, seeking funding for the Project as one of the local projects; and grant in the amount of \$538,051 for the pipeline construction component of the Project; and

WHEREAS, The estimated cost of construction for the Project is \$2.3 million, the Proposition 1 grant would fund up to \$538,051 to offset the pipeline construction costs of the Project, and the Water Enterprise Capital Improvement Project No. 10037519 would fund SFPUC's required cost share of \$422,849 as well as the remaining costs of construction; and

WHEREAS, The SFPUC desires to receive the Proposition 1 grant funds and is willing to cooperate in fulfilling grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, With Commission and Board of Supervisors authorization, the SFPUC and ABAG would enter into the Local Project Sponsor Agreement for ABAG to disburse up to \$538,051 of Proposition 1 grant funds to the SFPUC for the construction of the pipeline; and

WHEREAS, The Project is estimated to be advertised in June 2023 and construction is estimated to begin in February 2024 with projected completion by February 2025, with the pipeline construction portion completed by December 2024; and

WHEREAS, This grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment, and does not include funding for new staff members; and

WHEREAS, On June 13, 2023, the SFPUC Commission, by Resolution No. 23-0124, recommended that the Board of Supervisors accept this grant; and

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFPUC to accept and expend up to \$538,051 of Proposition 1 grant funds for the construction of the pipeline for the San Francisco Zoo Recycled Water Project, under Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1(b), for a term period of October 1 2023, through December 31, 2024; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it
