Resolution approving the grant agreement for Contract No. 1000032526 for three Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco programs: the George Washington Carver Beacon Community School; the Malcolm X Academy Beacon Community School; and Comprehensive Year-Round Learning, between the Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, for a total term of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of \$30,222,500.

WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for its 2024–2029 funding cycle; and

WHERAS, Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco submitted proposals for three programs under RFP Result Area: All Children and Youth are Ready to Learn and Succeed in School; and

WHEREAS, The three programs are: George Washington Carver Beacon Community School; Malcolm X Academy Beacon Community School; and Comprehensive Year-Round Learning; and

WHEREAS, Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco was awarded funding in all three programs; and

WHEREAS, Under the George Washington Carver Beacon Community School Program, Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco will provide academic support and enrichment activities to students at George Washington Carver Elementary School; and



RESOLVED, Under San Francisco Charter, Section 9.118, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City to enter into the grant agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and Boys & Girls Clubs of San Francisco to fund George Washington Carver Beacon Community School Program; Malcolm X Academy Beacon Community School Program; and Comprehensive Year-Round Learning Program during the period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029, for a total not to exceed amount of \$30,222,500; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the grant being fully executed by all parties, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall provide the final grant agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
