4 **Resolution approving the grant agreement for Contract No. 1000032537 for Centers for**  
5 **Equity and Success, Inc. programs: the Early Morning Study Academy; Credible**  
6 **Messengers; Inside/Out Pathways; and TAY/A Workforce Development, between**  
7 **Centers for Equity and Success, Inc. and the City and County of San Francisco, acting**  
8 **by and through its Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, for a total term of**  
9 **July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,804,000**  
10 **upon Board of Supervisor’s approval under Charter, Section 9.118.**

12 WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their  
13 Families issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for its 2024–2029 funding cycle; and

14 WHEREAS, Centers for Equity and Success, Inc. submitted proposals for four  
15 programs under the RFP Result Area: All Youth Are Ready For College, Work And Productive  
16 Adulthood; and

17 WHEREAS, The four programs are: Early Morning Study Academy; Credible  
18 Messengers; Inside/Out Pathways; and TAY/A Workforce Development; and

19 WHEREAS, Centers for Equity and Success, Inc. was awarded funding in all four  
20 programs; and

21 WHEREAS, Under Early Morning Study Academy Program, Centers for Equity and  
22 Success, Inc. will provide project and curriculum-based learning to build positive identities,  
23 increase student social and emotional learning and enhance leadership abilities; and

1           WHEREAS, Under Credible Messengers Program, Centers for Equity and Success,  
2 Inc. will provide services to San Francisco youth in custody at the Juvenile Justice Center to  
3 build on their strengths to transition to a productive adulthood; and

4           WHEREAS, Under Inside/Out Pathways Program, Centers for Equity and Success, Inc.  
5 will provide custody-based services and longstanding vocational training and arts programs  
6 tailored to meet the needs of youth in custody; and

7           WHEREAS, Under TAY/A Workforce Development Program, Centers for Equity and  
8 Success, Inc. will provide job readiness, education referrals, internships, on the job training,  
9 technology training, job placement, and follow up services to San Francisco youth ages 18-24;  
10 now, therefore, be it

11           RESOLVED, Under Charter, Section 9.118, that the Board of Supervisors hereby  
12 authorizes the City to enter into the grant agreement between the City and County of San  
13 Francisco and Centers for Equity and Success, Inc. to fund Early Morning Study Academy  
14 Program; Credible Messengers Program; Inside/Out Pathways Program; and TAY/A  
15 Workforce Development Program during the period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029,  
16 for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,804,000; and, be it

17           FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the modification being fully  
18 executed by all parties, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall provide  
19 the final grant agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.


