Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,281,000 from the California Department of Public Health for participation in a program, entitled "Fentanyl Overdose Prevention Grant," for the period of March 1, 2024, through February 28, 2027.

WHEREAS, The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has agreed to fund the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$1,281,000 for the period of March 1, 2024, through February 28, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Through the Fentanyl Overdose Prevention Grant, the DPH Office of Overdose Prevention will implement an innovative program entitled Advancing Racial Equity and Data-Driven Responses (AREDDR); and

WHEREAS, Through the AREDDR program, DPH will take a multi-pronged approach to addressing racial disparities in overdose-related fatalities; and

WHEREAS, DPH will contract with the San Francisco African American Faith-Based Coalition to implement a peer-led navigation program for existing clients receiving medication for opioid use disorder (MOUD) services and expanding access to and knowledge of MOUD, with a particular focus on the over-burdened Black/African American community in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, DPH will also work to strengthen its existing partnership and knowledge sharing with the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) to improve data-driven, equity-focused, real-time overdose response interventions; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the award letter on December 8, 2023, for a project start date of March 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,281,000 from the CDPH; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1.
