Resolution recognizing the month of September 2025 as Firefighter Appreciation Month

WHEREAS, September is nationally recognized as Firefighter Appreciation Month, a time to honor and celebrate the courage, dedication, and sacrifice of firefighters who tirelessly protect our communities every day; and

WHEREAS, This national observance to recognize firefighters reflects the deep gratitude felt by community members for the brave and selfless individuals who serve in the fire service, and the vital role they play in public safety and emergency response; and

WHEREAS, Firefighters risk their lives every day to protect the lives and property of those in their community, responding not only to fires but also to medical emergencies, natural disasters, and hazardous incidents with professionalism, bravery, and compassion; and

WHEREAS, California faces increasing risk of wildfires due to climate change, drought, and other environmental factors that threaten our State, and in recent years Californians have endured some of the most destructive fires in history, events that have claimed lives, displaced families, and devastated communities; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) is one of the busiest urban fire departments in the nation, responding to more than 175,000 calls for service annually, including over 135,000 emergency medical incidents, 5,600 fires, and hundreds of rescues; and

WHEREAS, SFFD operates 44 fire stations citywide and three additional stations at San Francisco International Airport, staffed by approximately 1,800 sworn personnel, with

specialized units including fireboats, heavy rescue squads, and hazardous materials teams, ensuring rapid response to emergencies across San Francisco's 49 square miles; and

WHEREAS, SFFD Station 3, serving the Tenderloin and surrounding neighborhoods, leads the department in activity, responding to 16,422 total calls, including 9,072 medical emergencies and 984 fires; and

WHEREAS, Beyond emergency response, the San Francisco Fire Department actively invests in community preparedness through its nationally recognized Neighborhood Emergency Response Team (NERT) program, which has trained more than 27,000 San Francisco residents since 1989 in disaster response skills such as light search and rescue, fire suppression, and medical triage, ensuring that neighborhoods are empowered to support one another during major emergencies; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco firefighters not only safeguard our residents but also provide critical support across California through the state's mutual aid system, deploying to wildfire zones and disaster areas when called upon; and

WHEREAS, The commitment, resilience, and public service of San Francisco firefighters deserve our deepest appreciation and respect; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby declares the month of September 2025 as Firefighter Appreciation Month in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That all residents, organizations, and community leaders are encouraged to take this opportunity to recognize, thank, and support the dedicated firefighters who serve San Francisco through public appreciation, community events, and ongoing advocacy for their safety and well-being.
