Resolution supporting the human rights of the people of Iran, including the immediate

WHEREAS, Protests erupted across Iran after Mahsa Amini, a 22-year old Iranian Kuridish woman, who was pronounced dead on September 16, 2022, in the custody of the Morality Police after she allegedly violated the strict Islamic dress code for women on September 13, 2022, and reportedly the improper wearing of the hijab in Tehran; and

WHEREAS, In response to her death, protesters have taken to the streets in more than 80 cities, towns, and villages across Iran; all while Iranian women are at risk of suffering brutality and death for perceived violations of a dress code imposed on them by others; and

WHEREAS, Reports indicate that Iranian security forces have used lethal force in killing hundreds of protesters and arresting more than 14,000 people, and are threatening to impose the death penalty on detained Iranians; and

WHEREAS, The Iranian Government has also restricted internet access, by cutting access to Instagram and WhatsApp to prevent communication, disrupting access to information, restricted freedom of expression, repressed the rights of Iranian citizens, journalists, and human rights defenders; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors stands with the people of Iran, particularly women and girls, who are engaged in legitimate and peaceful protests against an oppressive and corrupt regime, while asking for a free, secular, democratic,

republic of Iran where everyone can live freely and prosper regardless of their gender, sexual orientation, beliefs, and religion; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns the Islamic Republic and its agents who routinely and systematically violate human rights, restrict freedom of peaceful assembly and association and freedom of opinion and expression, including the continuing closures of media outlets, arrests of journalists, and censorship of expression in online forums; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors calls on the Iranian Government and security forces to cease their attacks and killing of those protesting Mahsa Amini's death, for a thorough and unfettered investigation by a trusted international body into the circumstances of her arrest and cause of death, and full accountability for all those determined to have been responsible for the death of Mahsa Amini and hundreds of others, and the arrests and human rights abuse of thousands of others.
