14 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly  
15 zoned and recommends approval; and

16 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of  
17 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business  
18 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of  
19 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with no new conditions; now,  
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,  
22 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
23 hereby determines that seeking the premise-to-premise transfer of a Type-51 non-profit
