RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the SFPD to accept and expend the grant award of \$654,609 from the BSCC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of Police, or his designee, to enter into agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, as well as execute extensions and amendments for this grant; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully executed by all parties, the Police Department shall provide the final agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
