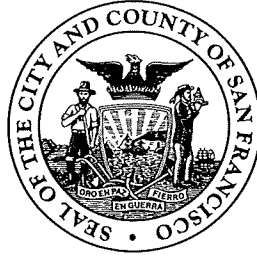

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO RULES COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Rules Committee will hold a public hearing to consider the following proposal and said public hearing will be held as follows, at which time all interested parties may attend and be heard:

- Subject:** **File No. 190869.** Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to affirm the County Agricultural Commissioner's authority under state law to certify and inspect farmers' markets and producers, and to enforce state law governing the direct marketing of agricultural products to consumers; replace the County Agricultural Commissioner with the Director of Property as the operator of City-operated farmers' markets and flea markets; eliminate the allocation of space at farmers' markets for the distribution of surplus commodities to needy persons; increase the permit fees for certified producers and other vendors; and increase the permit fees for farmers' market operators.

If the legislation passes, the following fees will be increased or established:

The County Agricultural Commissioner may charge a fee of \$113 per hour to defray the cost of conducting inspections of Certified Farmers' Markets.

Certified Producers must pay a fee increased from a variable/seasonal rate to a flat rate of \$50 per day to sell at City-Operated Farmers' Markets. Vendors must a fee of \$85 per day to sell at a City Operation Farmers' Market.

Each vendor at the Flea Market shall pay a daily fee increased from \$45 to \$50 per stall for each day on which the vendor sells.

The County Agricultural Commissioner is authorized to impose a fee for the issuance, modification, verification and renewal of a Farmers' Market certificate for any certified Farmers' Market as follows:


Certified Farmers' Market with fewer than 16 vendors: \$500;

Certified Farmers' Market with 16-45: \$1000; and

Certified Farmers' Market with more than 45 vendors: \$1500.

Beginning with fiscal year 2019/2020, and annually thereafter, the fees set forth in Administrative Code, Chapter 1, Section 1.10-1 "Farmer's Market Certifications Fee" may be adjusted each year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors. The Controller shall, if necessary, adjust the fees upwards or downward for the upcoming fiscal year, as appropriate, to ensure that the program recovers the costs of operations without producing revenue that is significantly more than such costs.

In accordance with Administrative Code, Section 67.7-1, persons who are unable to attend the hearing on this matter may submit written comments to the City prior to the time the hearing begins. These comments will be made a part of the official public record and shall be brought to the attention of the Members of the Committee. Written comments should be addressed to Angela Calvillo, Clerk of the Board, Room 244, City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco CA 94102. Information relating to the proposed fee is available in the Office of the Clerk of the Board. Agenda information relating to this matter will be available for public review on Friday, November 15, 2019.
